



Edward Smith Places in the Southeast Regional Goalie War Challenge

Edward Smith competed in the Southeast Regional Goalie War Challenge on June 15, 2008 in Marietta, Ga. The competition was held on the campus of Southern Polytechnic State University. Edward placed SECOND in the goalie war competition in his age division. The goalie war is a competition where goalkeepers go head to head and points are awarded for goals and saves. It is a timed event and the ball must change sides every 6 seconds.

Edward also competed in the punt, throw and kick competition where he came in FIRST place in the boys division. He also earned a FIRST place in the Cannon competition where he blocked 19 out of 20 shots on goal in two minutes. Details about the events are listed below.

Edward is now qualified to compete in the 2008 National Goalie War Championships in December in Orlando, Florida. The first and second place finalists in regional competitions automatically receive a bye in the first round of the national championships.

Edward plays for the 94 Lenoir Force Classic Soccer team. He is a rising 7th grader at William Lenoir Middle School.
